Dear Parent/Guardian,

The TNReady state assessments in math, English language arts, social studies, and science was given to all 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> Johnson County students and high school students in the required EOC courses during the past few weeks. These assessments will count for 10% of each student's last nine-weeks grade in each subject. Due to the fact that we are anticipated to not receive test results back from the state until the end of May, students in those tested subjects will not receive a report card on the last half day of school as they have in the past. Teachers will be notified this summer as soon as assessment results are back so that they can come in and finish calculating grades for the last nine weeks. As soon as teachers calculate the grades, principals will do a call out so that parents are aware that grade cards are being mailed. Parents can either check grades on the skyward portal or request for a grade card to be mailed to them.
